TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FRAMEWORK

The SADC Technical Regulations Liaison Committee (SADCTRLC), has been established to promote and facilitate implementation of the SADC Technical Regulation Framework







TECHNICAL REGULATIONS FRAMEWORK

"The objective of the Framework shall be the identification, prevention and elimination of unnecessary TBTs amongst the Member States and between SADC and other Regional and International Trading Blocks through harmonized standards, technical regulations and conformity assessment procedures in order to facilitate and increase trade in goods and services."







SADCTRLC Membership

"The SADCTRLC shall consist of representatives of government departments of SADC Member States that have been given the overall responsibility for compliance with the WTO TBT Agreement and the obligations set forth"





TECHNICAL REGULATIONS LEGISLATIVE INSTRUMENTS

"Member States shall ensure that the technical regulation is promulgated through a legislative instrument that describes the range of products covered, and / or the legitimate objective it intends to fulfil."



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TECHNICAL REGULATIONS LEGISLATIVE INSTRUMENTS

Member States shall ensure that responsible government departments and/or their regulatory agencies meet the obligations on advance notification through the National Notification Authorities in respect of the WTO TBT Agreement obligations on technical regulations that are to be implemented for their area of responsibility."





Implementation and Maintenance of Technical Regulations

"Member States shall implement a programme to update their existing technical regulations developed before this Annex came into force. Such a programme could include:

- a) Identifying all such existing technical regulations;
- b) Deciding whether these technical regulations are still required and, if not, having them removed;
- c) Deciding whether these technical regulations meet the requirements of this Annex and current technical developments, and if not having them revised; and
- d) Re-affirming and publishing technical regulations so reviewed and/or revised"





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IMPLEMENTATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

"Each Member State shall establish within 1 (one) year of adoption of this Annex, a function within government which will oversee the implementation of this Annex at national level for all future technical regulation work."





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CHALLENGES ON IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. Member States must ensure the relevant officers within Ministries of Trade are identified to run with the TRLC activities.
- 2. The TRLC members should have a coordinated approach at national level to enable effective consultative process when harmonised Technical Regulations are to circulated for national consultations.





CHALLENGES (ctd)

3. Member states must be willing to support the activities of SADCTRLC to ensure their representatives participate in most of the TRLC activities.





The SADCTRLC is a fairly young structure that is just gainining its feet after the first two complete years of operation.





Main activities include the identification, prioritization and the harmonisation of TRs.

Currently, the EXCO is working on the development of guidelines.





The first project has been the SADC Globally Harmonised System for classification and labelling of chemicals (SADC GHS) which is now at an advanced stage. A presentation will be done by the consultant on Wednesday.



The EXCO is also working on the road map to be followed in the whole process of harmonisation of TRs from start to finish including the consultative process and referencing to the relevant harmonized texts.





Conclusion

SADCTRLC now recommends that SADCSTAN consults with the TRLC on what Standards to prioritise for their harmonisation process so that once harmonised, they can be referred to by the TRs.
